WELCOME back to Term 3

Let us know when your child is away from school.

It is our shared responsibility for schools and whanau to work together to support attendance. This includes letting us know when your child is going to be away from school.

Under MOE quidelines absence due to medical reasons is defined as: Student absent due to short-term illness/medical reasons. Students are at home, or in hospital, because of illness or other medical reasons. These absences will be recorded as M - for Medical absence.

If your child is away and you do not get in contact with the school to let us know the reason for their absence they will be marked as absent- and this is recorded as UNJUSTIFIED.


Please let us know when your child is going to be away from school and the reason.
